Sympoietic Thinking Tool Terms of Reference... (You can also add your own...)

Lifecycle: Is it living? If you don't think so, how long has it existed on Earth? Will it cease?

Seven generations: a Haudenosaunee philosophy which encourages consideration of seven generations in each decision taken.

Symbiosis: a relationship or interaction between two different organisms (this can be both exosymbiosis (one organism lives outside the other of the organisims), endosymbiosis (one organism lives inside another).

Recognised types of symbiotic relationship:

Mutualism: both species benefit from the interaction *Commensalism:* One species benefits from the interaction and the other neither benefits or is harmed *Parasitism:* One species benefits from the interaction and the other is harmed or killed *Amensalism:* One species is harmed or killed by the interaction and the other is unaffected

Sympoetic: making with (often with more-than-humans)

Snygeosis: the extension of these emergent communal behaviours to include non-biological processes operating across the planet scale through deep time.
